variety show: AUDITION RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Only current Fulton Elementary School 4th-6th grade students can enter the variety show.
- Due to the number of participants wanting to perform, auditions MUST be held in order to have a variety show that meets our time constraints. Students MUST submit an audition video between April 27 and May 11th to be considered for the show. There will be no videos accepted after midnight on Wednesday, May 11th.
 - All who audition are *not* guaranteed a spot in the variety show.
- Students may only audition in ONE act.
- Acts are limited to 3 minutes (set up, performance & exit).
- Acts may include, but are not limited to: dancing, singing, playing an instrument, acting, poetry, comedy, magic, etc.
- The attached rubric will be used to judge each act.
- If selected, background music must be cut/stopped to only fit
 the length of the performance. We will supply microphones,
 CD player and piano, if needed. Any additional props and
 other necessities must be provided by the performer.
- Selected participants MUST attend the rehearsal (May 16 from 3:00 – 5:00 pm) and the in-school performance (May 18th from 1:15 – 2:45 pm) to participate.
- Students must comply with behavior expectations during school, auditions, rehearsals, and the performance. If students fail to adhere to these expectations, they will automatically be disqualified from the talent show.
- All themes must be appropriate for school. Any act that contains profanity, sexual language, suggestive sexual themes, or violence will be disqualified.
