

# UNICEF PICTURE PROJECT

**The task is quite simple: take a picture while holding up a poster saying:**

**“Every child has the right to live. #UNICEF”**

**Dates: Now until November 12, 2015**

**What to do: Take a QUALITY picture of yourself holding the poster, and send it to [unicefhhs@gmail.com](mailto:unicefhhs@gmail.com) with the subject line “Picture Project”. Inside the e-mail, include your name and the picture. The officers will e-mail you back if you do not send a quality picture.**

**Here’s the incentive:**

- **One picture = 30 min**
- **Each time you post your picture on any social media = 30 min/social media site (evidence needed: screenshot, etc. + can’t be deleted right after)**

- **If you make it your profile picture for more than a WEEK = 1 hr/social media site (evidence needed)**
- **If you get family/friends to do it with you = 10 min per new member (Just let us know in the e-mail)**
- **If you decide to take a picture with another UNICEF member, that's fine, just include both of your names in the e-mail.**

### **THE BEST PICTURES:**

- **The UNICEF members will vote on their top 3 favorite pictures at the end of the Picture Project.**
- **The winner(s) of the voting will receive 5 community service hours each.**

### **What will happen to all those pictures?**

- **Once the picture project is over, the UNICEF officers will make a collage of all of the pictures, and use the collage to spread awareness about UNICEF throughout all of Arizona!**
