Below are the CUSD game guidelines that will be implemented to start the 2020 Sports Season.

<u>Attendance</u>

- Up to 25% spectator capacity for Football Fields, and gyms.
- Fans are expected to leave all venues immediately after the game or match is completed.
- If you are providing transportation for a student athlete, we ask that you remain in your vehicle to wait for them

<u>Tickets</u>

- There will be no in-person sales/cash sales- all sales will be conducted through Go Fan online tickets
- Adult tickets will be available to Volleyball and Varsity football parents for purchase starting 8 am the Saturday prior to the event, sales will close Sunday at 10 pm before they go on sale to the general public at 8 am Monday
 - Limit 2 Adult tickets for Football/Cheer/Pom/Marching Band
 - Limit 2 Adult tickets for Volleyball
 - Limited Student tickets will be available with the general public sales
- A convenience fee applies to each ticket purchased
- In order to expedite the process, your whole party must be together and have your e-tickets ready prior to approaching the gate
- Once the event has reached 25% capacity, no additional tickets will be available
- The following policies will be enforced: No outside food/drinks (with the exception of sealed consumer water bottles), no large bags, and no re-entry

Fan Expectations

- Face masks need to be worn at all times
- Social distancing will be enforced. Families that reside together can sit together.
- Failure to follow CUSD guideline will result in removal from the event with no refund

As a reminder we ask that you practice grace and understanding. This has been a challenging time for everyone, and as a community we need to continue to do our part to make this a successful season.
