SPELLING: This week we will enter 20 new words into our spelling notebooks. For spelling homework this week, we will use list 7. Students will test on their list 7 words on Thursday.

LANGUAGE: The grammar focus this week will be pronouns and antecedents. We will practice these concepts in class.

MATH: We will continue with the Saxon math lessons, covering review concepts from 3rd grade math. Please make sure your child is reviewing the Saxon practice quiz Thursday evening prior to the test. The format and questions are EXACTLY the same as the practice test.
