"Attaining a medal or honorable mention for any student on the National Spanish Examinations is very prestigious," said Kevin Cessna-Buscemi, National Director of the Exams, "because the exams are the largest of their kind in the United States with over 157,000 students participating in 2017." The National Spanish Examination is a competition that is administered each year. The exams are sponsored by the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese.

Congratulations to four of our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students who were accepted to compete in the national math competition in June. We couldn't be more proud of their accomplishments!

As our last season of sports comes to an end, we are planning something a little different for our end of quarter sports reception. Each



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sport will host their own after school award celebration with cookies provided by our Booster Club. As playoff results are finalized, dates will be communicated to each team.
