FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

Senior exams will be given in regular classes on Thursday, May 19th and Friday, May 20th. Juniors graduating early will also follow this schedule. Juniors, please let your teachers know. If there are any concerns, contact Mr. Chandler as soon as possible.

SENIOR CHECK OUT

Seniors will receive check out forms in their English classes during the week of May 9TH. Any outstanding debts (including Chandler Public Library, athletics, class fees, uniforms, lost books, etc.) must be paid in full in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. **Check with the library and Bookstore now to see if you have any outstanding debts!** Completed/Signed forms (with any receipts attached) need to be returned to the Bookstore no later than 3:30pm on May 20th.

GRADUATION PRACTICE

Practice will be on Thursday, May 26th at 6:45am on the Basha High School football field. Please plan to be in the stadium no later than 6:40am. Practice is mandatory. **If you are not at graduation practice, you may not participate in the ceremony.** Do not bring your cap and gown to practice. Graduates with names that have difficult pronunciation, please see the readers after practice.

GRADUATION CEREMONY

The Graduation Ceremony will be **Thursday, May 26 @7:30PM at Basha High School's Jim Wall Stadium.** Students are to report to their assigned line-up location. **Students not present by 6:30pm will not be able to participate.** Remember the parking will be limited, so plan ahead and give yourself extra time. Please carpool if possible. **Following the graduation ceremony, all graduates will exit the stadium and continue the recessional to the parking lot. Please plan for families to meet there.**

If you choose not to participate in the graduation ceremony, please notify Chris Taylor, Mrs. Good's assistant, as soon as possible. Ms. Taylor can help you make arrangements to pick up your diploma after May 26th. She can be contacted at 480-224-2129.

Appropriate dress for seniors at graduation

- Students should arrive at Basha High School on May 27th by 6:30pm, CARRYING their gown.
- Students should not put their gown on until AFTER they have been checked in with their line leaders.
- Students will NOT be allowed to carry any items with them (including food or drink, clothes-hangers or flowers) into the stadium.
- Please leave all items with a family member before entering your line-up location. Staff members will be taking unauthorized items. Confiscated items will be available at BHS the following day.
- **MALES** should wear dress slacks, a collared shirt (tie not required, but recommended,) comfortable dress shoes and socks. No tennis shoes, flip flops or shorts will be allowed.
- **FEMALES** should wear a dress, or pants/skirt and blouse and comfortable dress shoes. No tennis shoes, flip flops or shorts will be allowed.
- **Mortarboards** (caps) should not be altered in any way nor should anything (other than the appropriate tassel) be attached to or written on it. Only BHS provided graduation apparel may be worn; no pins, flowers, etc. allowed.
- Any student who appears to be under the influence of a controlled substance will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony and fall under the jurisdiction of Chandler Police.

CUSD ATHLETICS CLEAR BAG POLICY:

Prohibited Items

For the safety and security of our guests, all prohibited items must be returned to the owner's car or discarded.

The following items are prohibited inside any CUSD Athletics venue and are causes for removal.

- Soft or hard sided coolers, ice chests
- Glass or metal containers
- Outside food and beverages
- Use of alcohol and tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco
- Backpacks, diaper bags and other similar bags will not be allowed
- Bikes, skateboards, scooters, hover boards, long boards
- Sticks, poles or similar objects that can be used as a weapon
- Weapons of any kind including those carried with permit
- Fireworks, drones or laser pointers
- No pets/animals
- Tortillas, frisbees, beach balls
- Artificial noisemakers (Example: air horns, thunderstix, musical instruments, cans filled with contents, whistles, cow bells or any other item used to make artificial noise)

- Large golf umbrellas

Only the following items will be permitted upon entrance into CUSD Athletics facilities:

- Bags that are clear plastic (Any size)
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags (no larger than 4.5" x 6.5") with or without a handle or strap can be taken into the venue
- Medically necessary items after proper inspection at gates
- Factory sealed water bottles 51 oz. / 1.5 liters or smaller (Site Preference)
- Service animals
- Seat cushions and chair backs must be 18" or less in width (No pockets, zippers, compartments, or covers)
