ROUGH DRAFT SENTENCE CHECK LIST

SUBECT: find your subject, what is doing the action and circle it

ARTICLES & DEMOS: Check the article or demonstrative to make sure it has agreement

ADJECTIVES: check that adjectives are behind the word it describes & for agreement. Squiggle the adjectives

VERB: what verb action is the subject performing? underline the <u>verb</u>

ADVERBS: check that the word that describes the action is behind the verb & double underline the <u>adverb</u>

DIRECT OBJECT: what is receiving the direct action from the verb? draw an arrow connection the verb & DO and check for agreement

INDIRECT OBJECT: to whom and for whom is that action happening? draw an arrow pointing down to whom it is happening and check for agreement

¿QUESTION? check to make sure the interrogative has an accent. Remember verb-subject order

reflexive pronouns, DOP, IOP go BEFORE the conjugated verb, or attached at the end of the infinitive
