The Lady Wolves Soccer Team finished an outstanding season last Tuesday, losing 2-0 to Desert Vista in the State semifinal game.

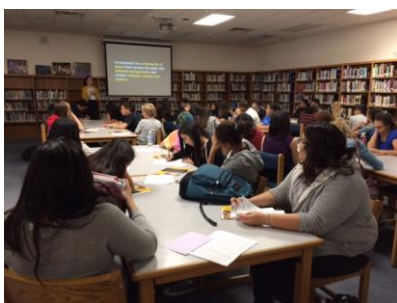

CHS BANDS PERFORM “DANCE, LOVE AND ...MARCH?”

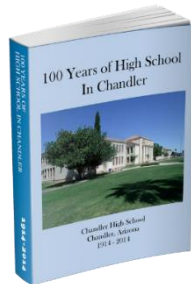

FEBRUARY'S NAEP TESTING

On February 19th, approximately 50 CHS Seniors will sit for the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), also known as *The Nation's Report Card*. The 50 students were chosen randomly and will test in either reading, math or science. The test results inform the public how students across the country, not just in one particular school or state, are doing.
