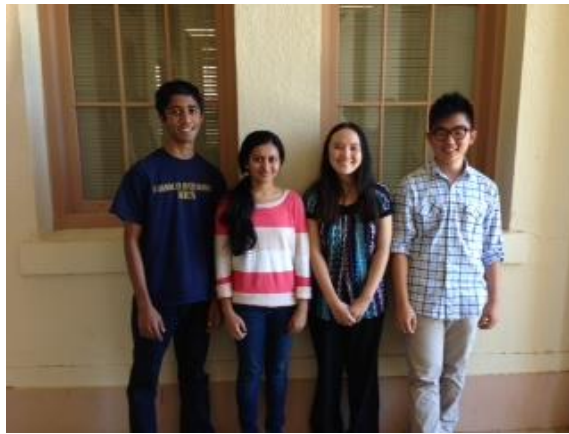


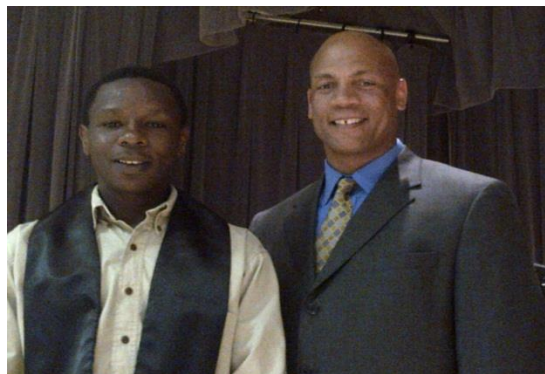


## WINNING WOLVES

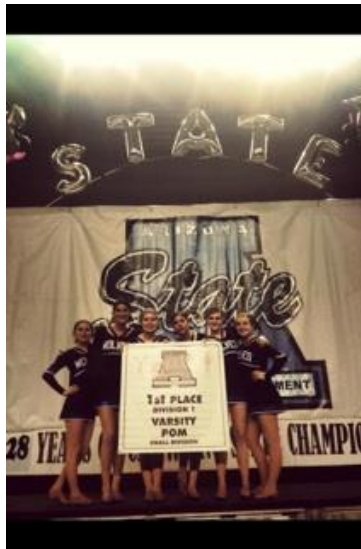

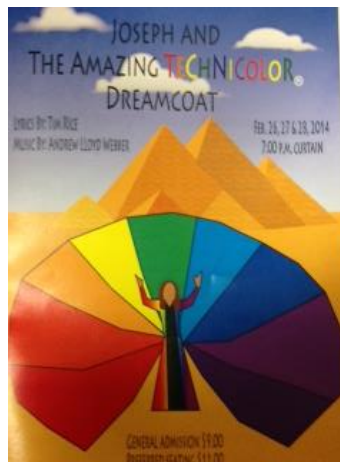

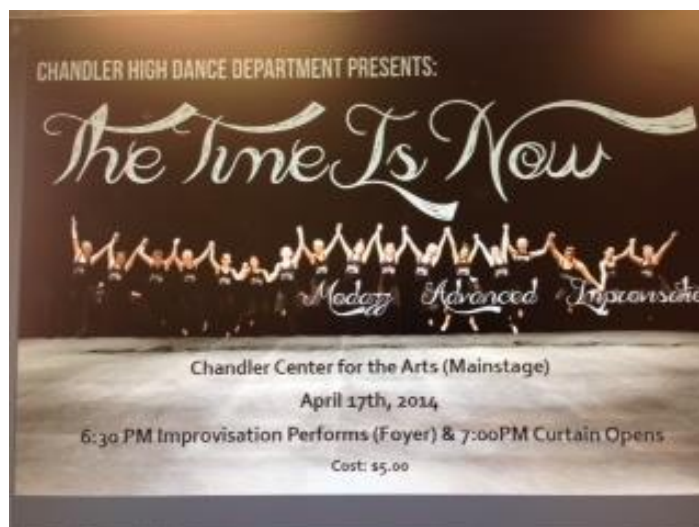
