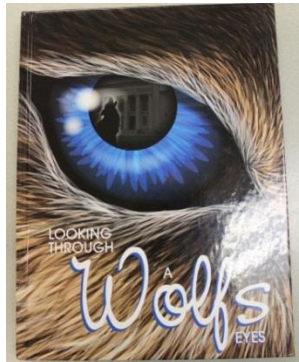
CHS STUDENTS PRESENT AT GILBERT MAYOR'S AMBASSADOR FORUM

PSAT

The PSAT/NMSQT will be administered at Chandler High School on Saturday, October 19 from 7:30 a.m. – 11 a.m. Students are encouraged to take the test for the first time during their sophomore year. Juniors should take the PSAT to qualify for scholarships, including the prestigious National Merit Scholarship. Students should report to the CHS Bookstore to register. The fee is \$20. Benefits of taking the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test include:

- Provides preparation for the SAT
- Allows students the opportunity to enter competitions for scholarships
- Helps students begin college and career planning
- Helps assess academic skills necessary for college-level work

ECAP UPDATE

The Arizona Department of Education requires all students to have an Education and Career Action Plan (ECAP). Chandler High School uses Kuder Navigator to help students explore career options and make connections between coursework and the world of work. Students are introduced to portfolio development and course planning. Kuder Navigator also provides guided exploration through a Career Planning Timeline, and it allows parents to play an important active role in their student's planning process.
