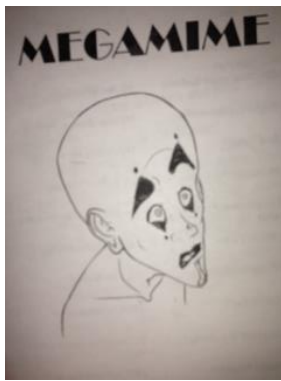
DRAMA UPDATE
