 - Research the careers available in your military and choose one.
 - List the benefits given to you by the military of your choice
 - o TIMELINE: How many months or years will your training take? Be specific.

- Set 3 stair-step goals for you to attain this career.
- Any other specialized education or training that will be required after high school.
- What you are expected to do on a daily/weekly basis in your position for that organization.
