While school buildings are closed, school instruction is not. Your teachers and support staff are working diligently to ensure all of our students have instruction, support for learning and the necessary materials to complete their work. Additionally, we are working to make sure your personal needs are met through by providing information about access to meals, food items and assistance available in our community.

Many of you have asked about picking up your students' personal items from school. We have developed a plan for distribution of instructional packets, PTO fundraiser items, Weekender Food Bags, and student's personal items. This will also enable us to collect Shumway library books and District instruments (if not in use) at the same time – while also following CDC guidelines for social distancing and personal safety.
