Health Services

Medications will be given in the school health office **ONLY** if they **MUST** be administered during school hours. Medications to be given two and three times daily are to be given at home, unless specifically ordered by the doctor to be given at school.

Medications should be delivered to the school health office by the parent. The medication must be in the original container from the pharmacy. Pharmacies will provide a duplicate container for school use upon request. The appropriate consent for giving medication at school must be completed and signed by the parent and the physician.

Limited over the counter medications are available as needed in the health office for treating minor conditions. The appropriate consent for giving acetaminophen must be completed and signed by the parent.

- Call the absence report line to report daily absences. The absence line is **480-812-7403** and is available 24 hours a day.
- Student drop off/pick up is located directly in front of the school. Double parking is not allowed. Please do not leave your vehicle unattended. We ask that you observe the 15 M.P.H. speed limit.
- Always sign in and out at the front desk and please wear a visitor badge when you are on our campus.

Student Use of the Phone

Infinite Campus Portal

We believe it is very important for parents and guardians to be involved in their child's learning. Communication between home and school is vital to this partnership. For this reason, we utilize our Infinite Campus program to send frequent newsletters, updates and reminders electronically. Dress for Success!

Uniform dress for all Shumway Leadership Academy Students will be as follows:

Tops: any solid black, red or white collared shirt; long or short sleeve – sleeveless tops are not permitted

Bottoms: any solid black or khaki shorts, pants, skirts or jumpers provided they meet student dress code expectations as outlined in the CUSD Elementary Handbook. Leggings, joggers & colored jeans are not uniform dress.

Accessories: students are free to choose socks, shoes, jackets/sweaters/sweatshirts and accessories provided all accessories meet the student dress code expectations as outlined in the CUSD Elementary Handbook.

Free Dress Fridays: each Friday will be a "free dress" day where students have the option to wear either their uniform dress or their street clothes meeting expectations as outlined in the CUSD Elementary Handbook.

School Spirit Days: Shumway will continue the tradition of school spirit days throughout the year where students will be encouraged to participate instead of wearing uniform dress for those days.

The following are prohibited and will be enforced on Free Drees Days & Sprit Days:

- Any spaghetti strapped shirts, camisoles, tank tops, and dresses with less than a two-inch shoulder strap
 - 3 spaghetti-strap shirts, laye red, do **NOT** make up one school appropriate shirt
 - Racer-back tank tops with bra strap or thin cami strap showing
 - Halter or one shoulder tops which expose the entire upper back and/or shoulders
- Any clothing that bares the midriff or reveals undergarments
- Saggy, bagging pants not worn at waist
- Hats are to be worn straight on the head, brim forward, and **outside** only
- Shirts or jewelry promoting sex, drugs, alcohol, gangs, or violence
- Belts and/or chains hanging below the waist
- Sheer, see-through blouses and/or shirts
- Shorts and skirts (must be thumb length with arm fully extended to the side)
- Unnaturally colored hair

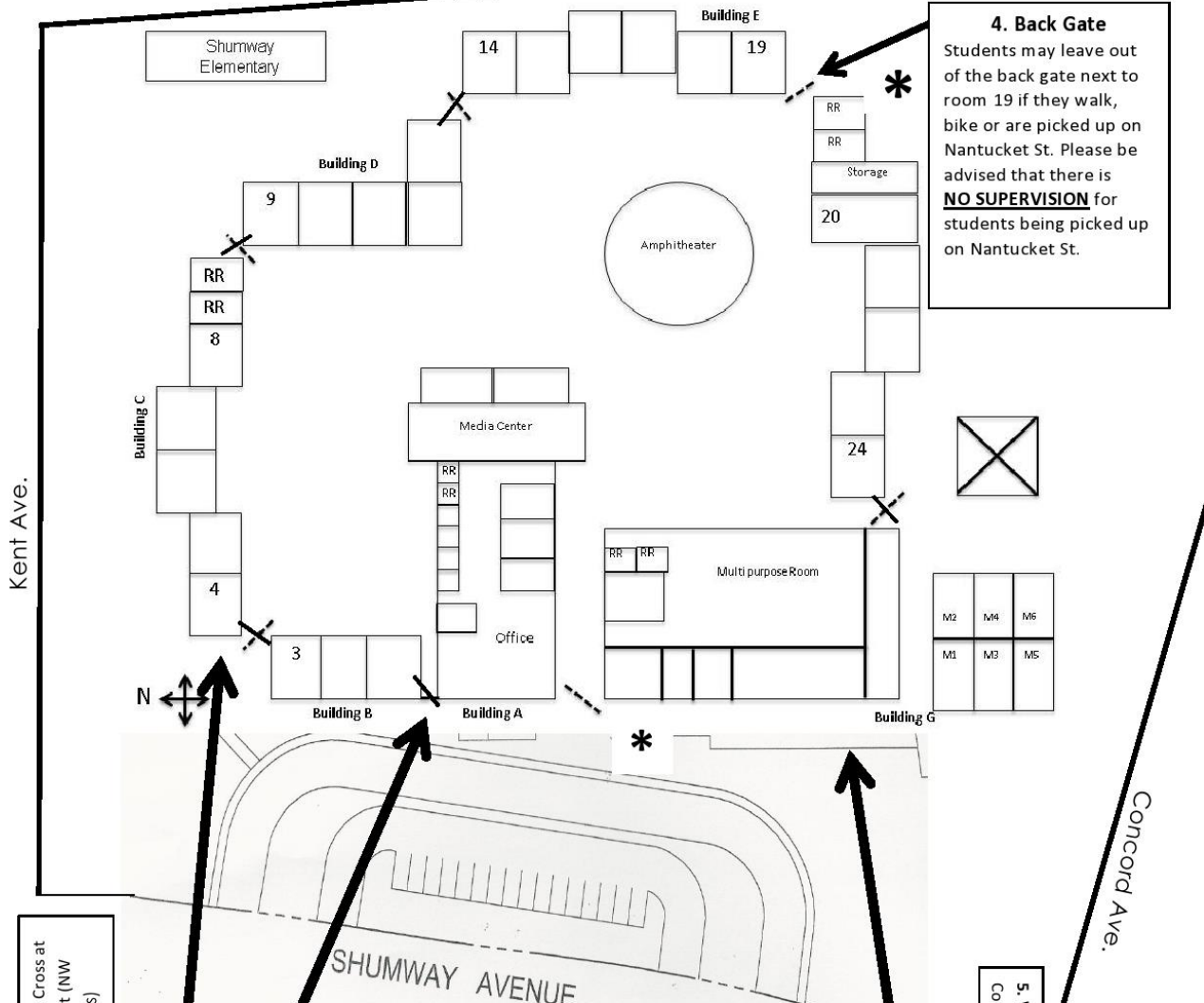
The following footwear is not acceptable:

- Shoes with built-in wheels, bare feet, shoes with overly tall heels
- Note: Flip flops are not recommended for daily wear and are not acceptable for P.E. days



Students violating the dress code will be asked to change or call a parent to bring a alternate clothes. We appreciate your early attention and compliance with these standards of dress. This expectation starts on the very first day of school. .

4. Back Gate
