

Fall 2020 Leadership Grade

To improve the leadership activities of our chapter and to create a better forum for sharing ideas, we have created a Leadership Grade that will be a part of the semester grade. This grade will be based on your attendance at specific leadership activities and your participation in the FFA organization.

There will be **300** (advanced students) or **200** (new students) **points required per semester** for the Leadership Grade. Students with the highest leadership points for the year will be rewarded with a high points activity. Students may earn up to 25% of their leadership points by participating in other school events (sports, fine arts, academic clubs, etc).

25 pts	**Serve as Chapter Officer

15 pts	Participate in social media challenge (Max 5 times)
