AR POINT GOALS

Goals will be sent home after the second week of school and are due Friday, Sep.20. The AR goal has **three components**:

1. Overall accuracy: 90% or higher
2. Meeting 100% of point goal
3. Meeting nonfiction goal, which is to earn 2.5 nonfiction points, scoring 80% or higher and maintaining overall accuracy of an average of 85%
