## DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual Enrollment is an opportunity for eligible high school students to earn lower-division college credit during their regular high school classes.

#### AP VS. DUAL ENROLLMENT

A student can spend the whole year in an AP class, but receiving college credit is dependent on their AP test score at the end of the year. Dual Enrollment classes are based on the grade a student receives in the class; if they receive a grade of C or better, they get college credit.

# HOW DO I KNOW WHAT CLASSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Not all classes are eligible for Dual Enrollment. Teachers must be certified to teach at the college level and complete registration with CGCC. Eligible courses can be viewed on Basha's class list available at cgc.edu/dual

### BENEFITS

- Community college tuition rates are much lower than state universities' tuition rates. Students pay roughly one-third the tuition they would pay at a state university.
- Books are provided by Basha, so students have the benefit of not having to spend hundreds of dollars on textbooks each semester.
- Students can start college with several credits already completed and with an already wellestablished GPA
- These challenging courses enhance high-level thinking skills. which prepare students for college/university classes
