A

Attendance. School starts each day at 8:40. We do lots of work each day and missing just a day can make it harder to keep up!

C

Communication. It is key. If you need anything or if your child says something that I need to know please call or email!

E

Email. Please email me whenever you need. I can usually reply more promptly than by the phone. I will also need your email address.

G

Great behavior. I expect great behavior all the time. There are rewards - notes, praise, treasures, and treats.

I

Independence. Your student can do a lot more than you think. Look for times to allow them to do the work.

K

Keeping Updated. Please check for a weekly email from me with all the important updates.

B

Breakfast. Your student needs fuel to get through the morning! Make sure they have a good start with a good breakfast.

D

Dismissal. If you change your dismissal way, please let the office know (and they will let me know.)

F

Folder. Your child will have a daily folder. Please check it daily and remove anything from it that needs to stay home.

H

Homework. Please read to and with your child every night.

J

Journal. We will keep many journals throughout the year.

L

Lunch. We eat lunch at noon. You can pay for lunch in the cafeteria or send the money in a labeled envelope or baggie.

Morning. We will meet each morning next to the playground. Students will walk directly to the classroom after the morning bell.

Open-Door Policy. Please speak up if there is something.

Q

Questions. Please question your child each day after school. Ask what they learned, who they played with, and what they ate.

S

Specials. We go to music, library, and PE 2 times per 6 day schedule. (One special per day.)

U

Unfinished Work. We will have lots of this. Please finish it up at home and send back if you wish.

W

Water. Your child can bring a water bottle to school each day only if it seals completely. (It must not leak and cannot be juice.)

Y

Your help. Please check the folder each day, read each night, and clean out their backpacks daily!

N

News. If your child has any important news please share it with me. Not only will this help with learning but it will help me to connect with your children as people.

P

Patience. Please be patient the first few weeks of school. Training 600+ kids to get to and from school is tricky.

R

Recess. Students get two recesses daily: lunch recess after they eat and afternoon recess.

T

Teacher. That's me! I have taught for 18 years - the last ten in the early grades. I love teaching first grade!

V

Volunteer. We love them! But please give us a few weeks to get our routines down and rapport with the students. A note for this will come home when we are ready.

X

eXperience. Kids come to school with all sorts of them. Some can read, some have never be away from family. Please don't worry about if your child is behind or ahead at this point.

Z

ZZZZ's. Kids need lots of sleep. And expect them to be tired at the end of the day - they work hard in school and it takes awhile to get used to.
