This notebook is a great tool to communicate about your child's progress, both academically and behaviorally. We also use this Leadership Notebook to help your child set goals and work towards achieving those goals.

For tonight's Family Challenge, we are asking families to spend time reviewing their child's Leadership Notebook. We have provided some discussion questions to help guide your conversation.

Leadership Notebook Questions:

- How many sections are in your notebook?
- Can you tell me about one thing behind your "Myself" tab?
- Do you have a personal/class mission statement?
 - Can you recite your class mission statement?
 - How did you create your class mission statement?
- Do you have a family mission statement in your Leadership Notebook?
- What is the school mission statement? Is it in your Leadership Notebook?
- Who decides what goes into your notebook? Who does the notebook belong to?
- What do you have in your "Celebration" section? Does everything in this section have to be school related?
- Can you tell me about the data in your "My Learning" section?
- What is a WIG? What is your WIG? What are your action steps to achieve your WIG?
- Do you have Leadership Roles in your classroom? How do you get a leadership role? What is your favorite Leadership Role you have had this year?
- Who is your Accountability Partner? How often do you meet with them?
- Do you like these notebooks? Why?
