Types of assessments

Formative

- Frequentassessmentmeantto gather information, inform teaching and clarify learning goals.
- Use evidence and actionable feedback to move student learning forward by adjusting teaching and learning strategies, goals, and/or next instructional steps.

Summative

- Assessment meant to measure end-of-year/ course proficiency (e.g., State achievement tests)
- Inform improvement strategies: teacher/program.
- Meet accountability requirements.
- Gauge student achievement of standards.
- Establish and evaluate school/district goals.

Benchmark

- Assessment administered periodically (beginning, middle, end-of-year)
- Provide data on student learning relative to expected learning goals.



Curriculum - Instruction - Assessment

The goal of assessment is to improve student learning. In a balanced assessment framework, each assessment has a clear, specific educational purpose, clear targets or goals, and sound design (ADE, 2018). Assessment data results are shared with stakeholders and the learning process is enhanced because curriculum, instruction, and assessment work on a continuous feedback loop. (Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, 2009).

<u>Instructional</u> - Provides information for the teacher to improve teaching and learning.

Evaluative - Helps identify what students know and can do, so teachers can support their learning.

<u>**Predictive</u>** - Predicts success on a future assessment (ex. state test)</u>
