As a member of Basha High School’s Link Crew, I promise to:

1. Show dedication and responsibility

_____ I will attend the following required Link Crew events:

- **May Development Day:** Tuesday, May 21st, 2019, 2:30 pm – 4:30 pm
- **Link Leader training:** Monday, July 15th, 2019 from 7:30 am – 12:30 pm
- **Freshman Orientation:** Friday, July 19th, 2019, 7:00 am – 12:30 pm
- **First day of school:** Tuesday, July 23rd, 2019 wear your Link Leader shirt and help freshmen with directions and questions
- **Attend 3 Link Crew events of your choice:** Date to be announced; Committees will decide on events at the beginning of the year and then you sign-up based on your schedule!
- **Conference meetings/events to be announced** – commitment and activities will vary based on determined activities and committee decisions. You are required to attend 80% of conference meetings in order to remain in good standing.

_____ I will attend team meetings (times and conference periods to be announced) and notify my team leader if I have a scheduling conflict.

_____ I will do my part in all Link Crew related activities.

_____ I will actively find answers to any Link Crew related questions.

_____ I will regularly keep in contact with my Crew throughout the year.

I _____ (print full name) understand that if I choose to not follow these expectations or act irresponsibly, in or out of school, I **could** be removed from the program at any time during the school year. BHS’s Link Crew has a two-strike system. At the first offense, the student is suspended from Link Crew for 20 weeks. At the end of this suspension, the student may re-apply to Link Crew. If the student has another offense, he or she is removed from Link Crew permanently. These strikes accrue for the student’s entire time in Link Crew. This policy adheres to Basha High School’s *Student Code of Conduct* as well as Link Crew’s philosophy that Link Crew Leaders “be a presence on campus as models of positive behavior.”

As a Basha High School Link Crew Leader, I understand these policies and the consequences if I choose to violate them. I am aware that failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in my dismissal as a Link Crew Leader.
