**Opioid Awareness and Prevention**

Community outreach coordinators from the Attorney General's Office will address the opioid epidemic that plagues Arizona. They will discuss numerous topics related to both use of prescription opioids as well as illicit usage, focusing on prevalence, prevention, and support.

**Anti-Bullying**

In this presentation community outreach coordinators from the Attorney General's Office will cover the different types of bullying, how it's affecting our youth, and preventative measures parents can take. They will explain why teaching kindness and being empathetic is important and the relationship it has with bullying. They will also give tips to parents on how to help their child become resilient to criticism.
