# HELPFUL TIPS FOR DISTANCE LEARNING



1. Find a quiet workspace
  - A. Mute cell phone
  - B. check your background to see what is behind you if we are live.
  - C. Let family members know “class is in session” so you are not interrupted.
2. Take care of your personal needs before sitting down to your device.
3. Follow norms for communication during live sessions or when sharing ideas on Google Classroom.
  - A. Take turns
  - B. Treat each other with kindness and respect when speaking or typing.
  - C. Mute microphone when not speaking.
  - D. Speak clearly.
  - E. Use the chat feature to post questions or comment like you would if you were called on in class.
4. Come ready to learn and focus on the task at hand.
5. If you cannot attend a class session, let me know via email or Remind and check Google Classroom for missing work.
