BOYS VOLLEYBALL

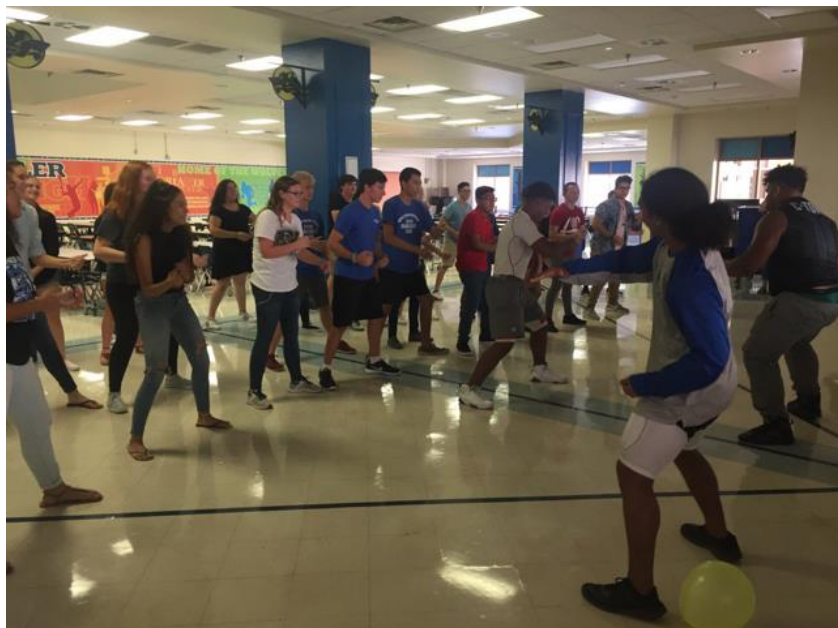
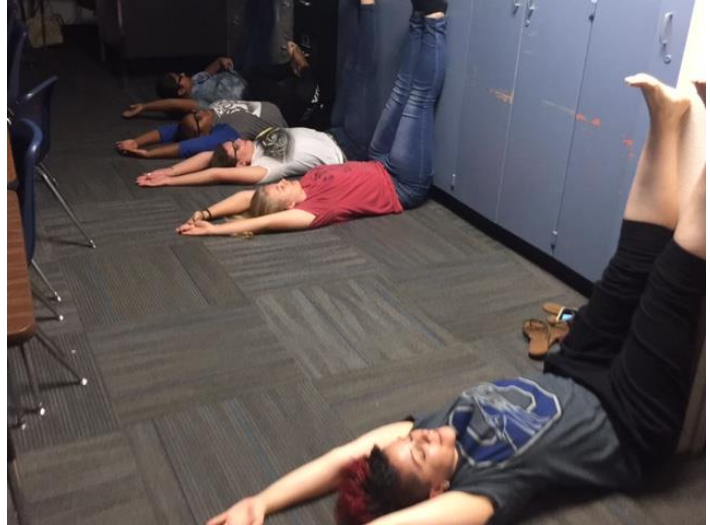
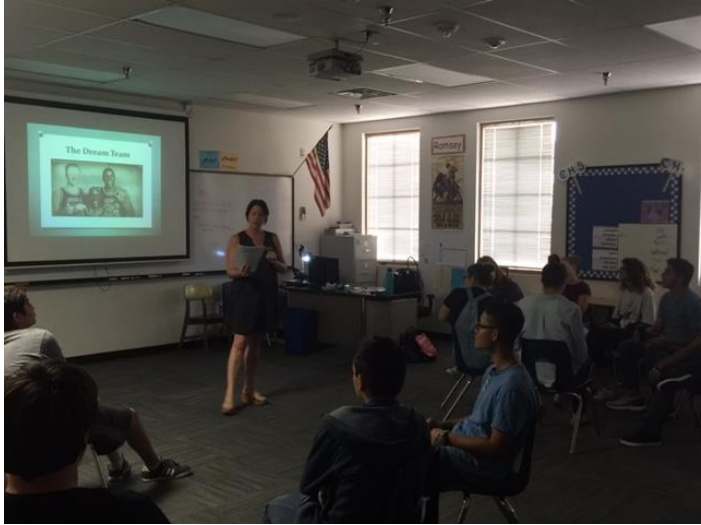
Boys Volleyball won the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Team Academic Award for the second consecutive year. Chandler High Boys Volleyball was 1 of 21 Boys HS programs to receive the award. The 2016-17 team had an overall 3.45 GPA.

The award, which was initiated in the 1992-93 academic year, honors collegiate and high school volleyball teams that displayed excellence in the classroom during the school year by maintaining at least a 3.30 cumulative team grade-point average on a 4.0 scale.

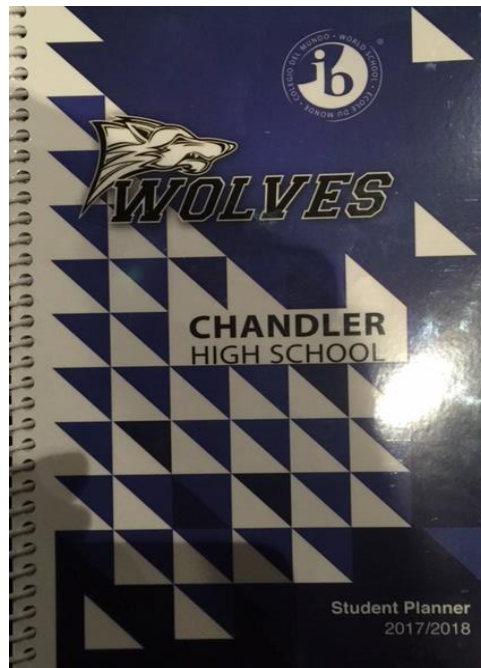


Starting this Wednesday, Lombardo's Gelato will be available for sale during both lunches in the courtyard. \$2 or \$3 sizes are available.

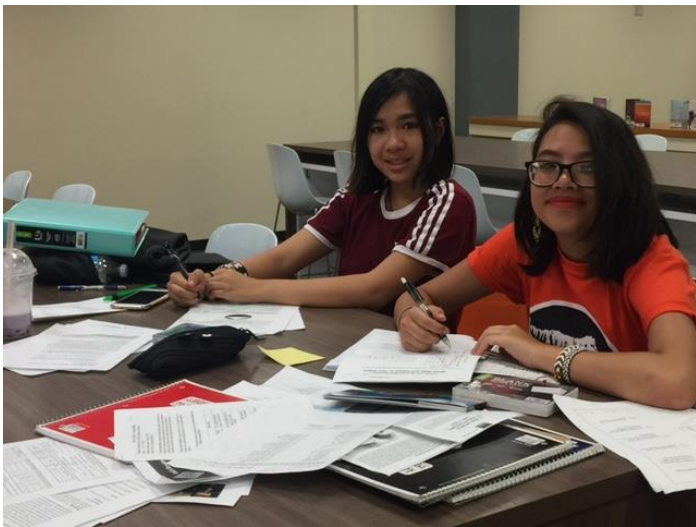
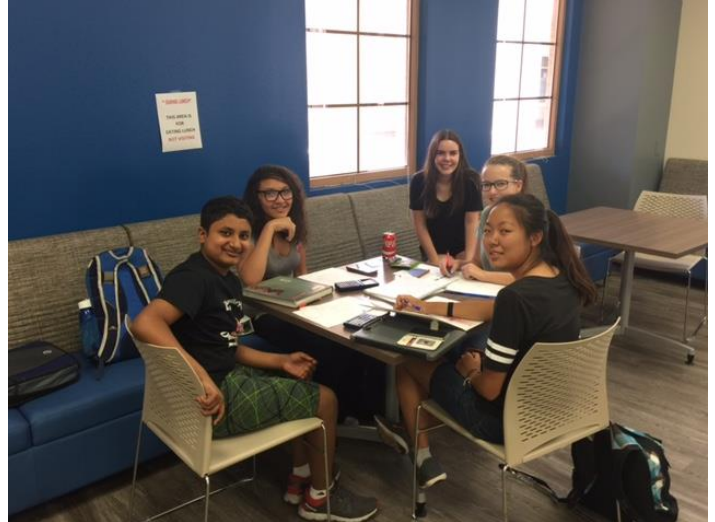
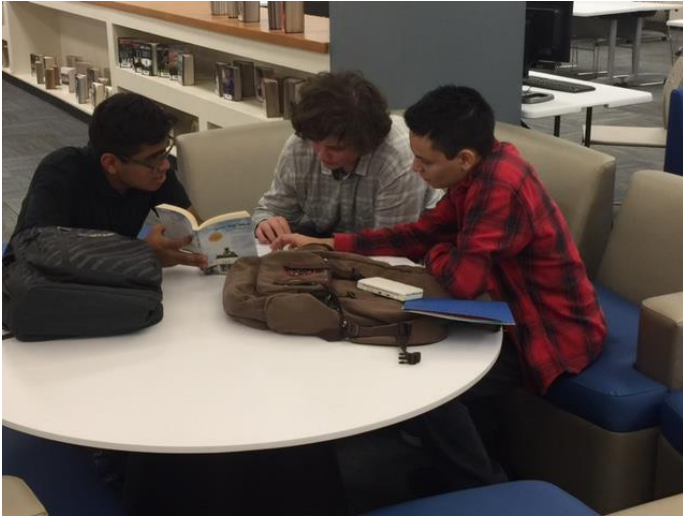


SWIB

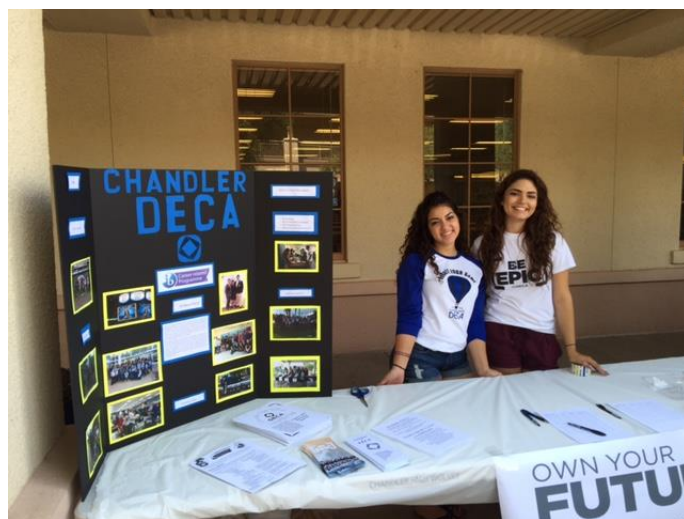
DANCING WITH WOLVES
