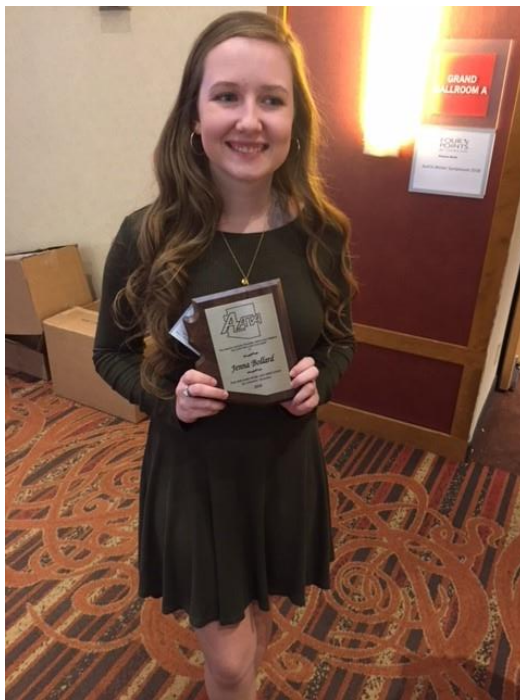
GOOD CITIZEN AWARD

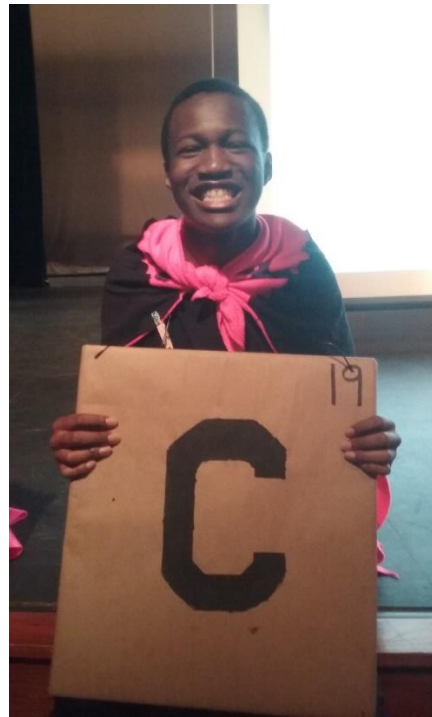

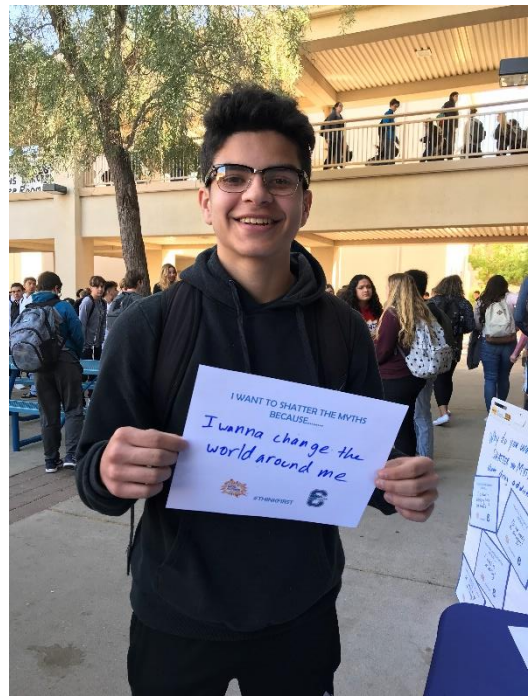
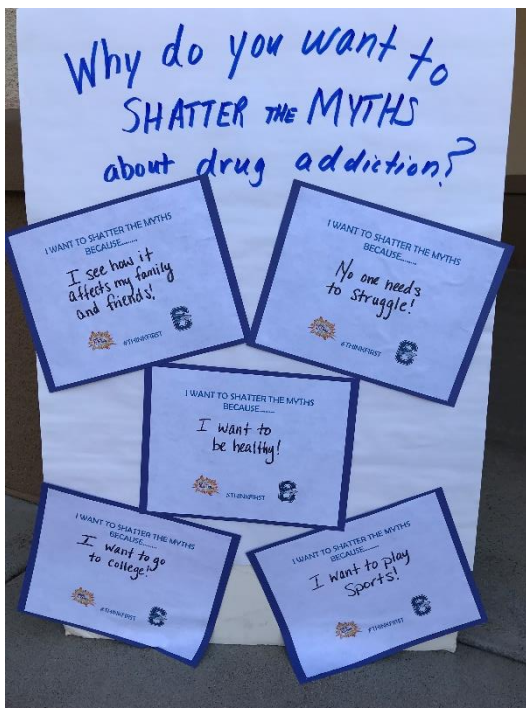
“not be scared” about being a leader and were energized to return to their school to continue to make a difference.
