LINK CREW TRAINING AND LEADERSHIP

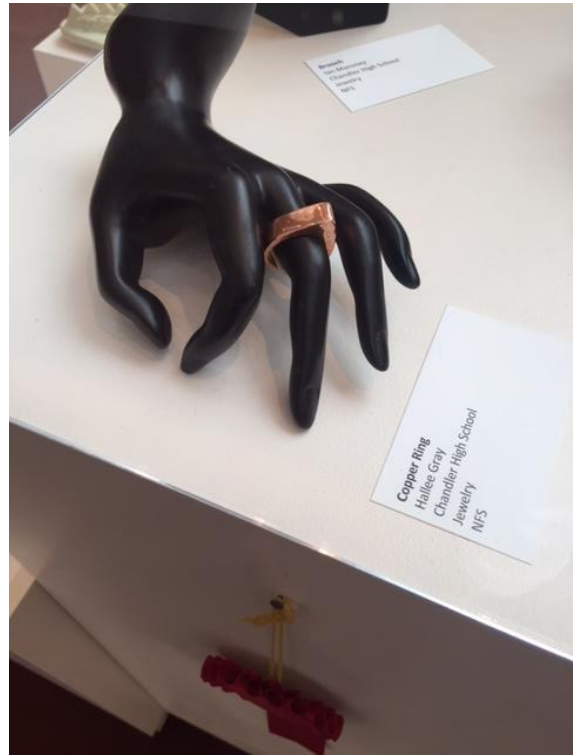

DUAL ENROLLMENT TUITION ASSISTANCE

Do you plan on doing Dual Enrollment classes next school year and need help with the cost?

Applications for the Maricopa Grant are due by:

Priority Deadline: **Thursday, May 31st**

Final Deadline: **Friday, August 31st**

Don't miss the deadline and miss your chance to be awarded tuition for your dual enrollment classes! Funds are awarded on a **first-come first-serve basis** and eligibility is based on financial need. If you don't apply now and decide this fall to take a dual enrollment class, the funds may be gone.

There is no commitment to register for classes if your plans change in the fall, but applying now allows you to determine your eligibility and become pre-qualified for funding.

Students must apply now to receive tuition assistance for the dual classes they plan on taking in the 2018-2019 school year. - **Monday, April 2nd** - ELA Writing for all students in English 9, English 10 and English 11 (includes Honors/AP/IB/ELD classes)- **10:25am Late Start for students not testing**
- **Tuesday, April 3rd** - ELA Reading for all students in English 9, English 10 and English 11 (includes Honors/AP/IB/ELD classes)- **10:25am Late Start for students not testing**
- **Wednesday, April 4th**- Math for all students in Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2 (includes Honors)- **10:25am Late Start for students not testing**

AIMS Science Testing

- **Wednesday, April 18th** for 9th and 10th graders in Biology, H Biology or Applied Bio **10:45am Late Start for students not testing**

ACT Testing

- **Tuesday, April 24th** for all juniors- **11:50am late start for 9th, 10th and 12th graders**

All testing begins at 7:25am. There will be no zero hour on testing days. We are running two bus routes each day of testing, the regular route for testers, and a second route for non-testers. Students not testing AzMERIT or AIMS Science will catch their bus 3 hours later than regularly scheduled pick-up. On April 24th, freshmen, sophomores and seniors will catch their bus 4 hours later than regularly scheduled pick-up.

All college presentations will take place in the CHS College and Career Center, unless otherwise specified. Students should sign up outside the CHS College and Career Center to attend a presentation. Students will receive a pass in class on the day of the presentation.
