TEAM CAMP FORMAT

The format of the camp was one of the most valuable aspects of the camp for many coaches and athletes that have attended in the previous years. In this format athletes and coaches will be instructed by a featured clinician in a large group for 1 hour and then they will be able to choose 2 additional 45 minute breakout sessions that they would like to see. This allows athletes and coaches to choose the technique sessions that best fits their wrestling style.
