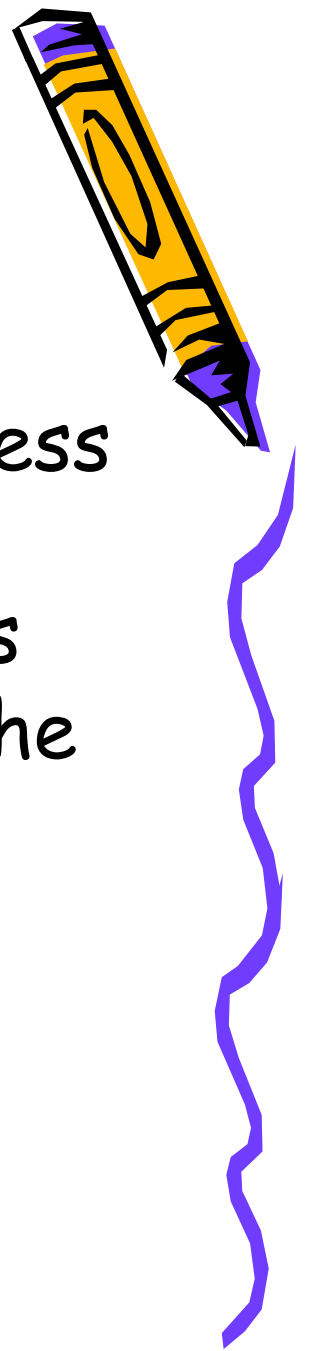
Reminders

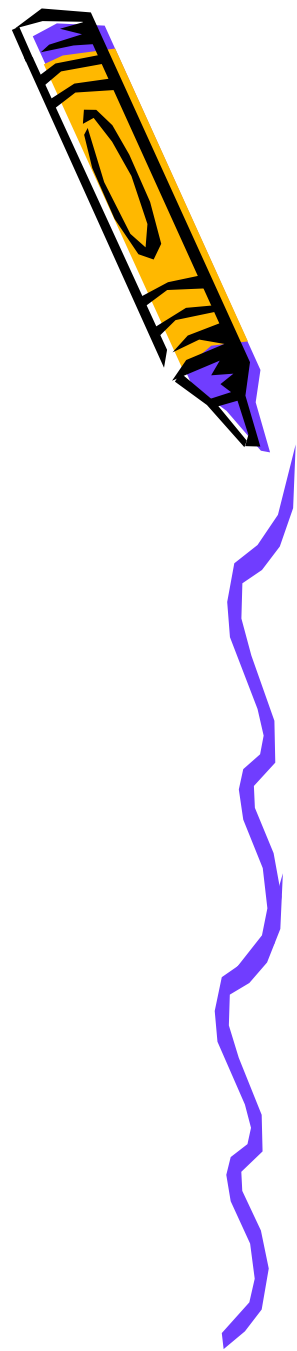
- Please help your child dress for success every day by making sure he/she is wearing clothing that not only follows our school dress code, but that he/she can take on and off independently.

- P.E. - tennis shoes (Days 1 & 4)



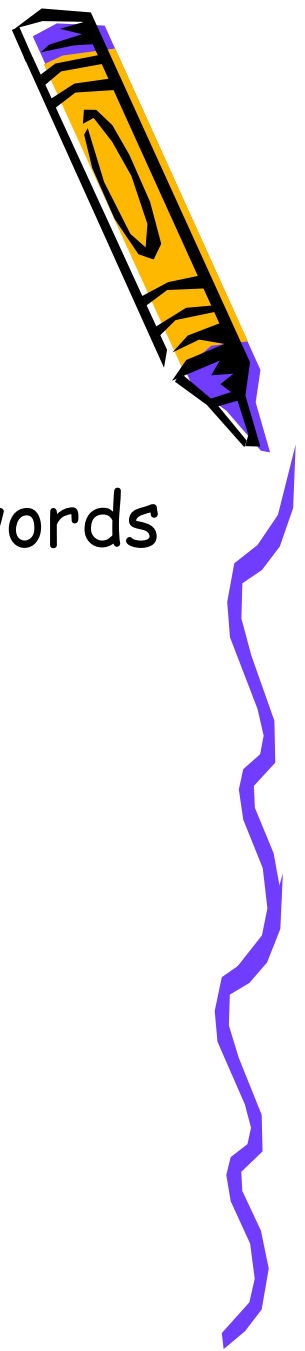

Communication

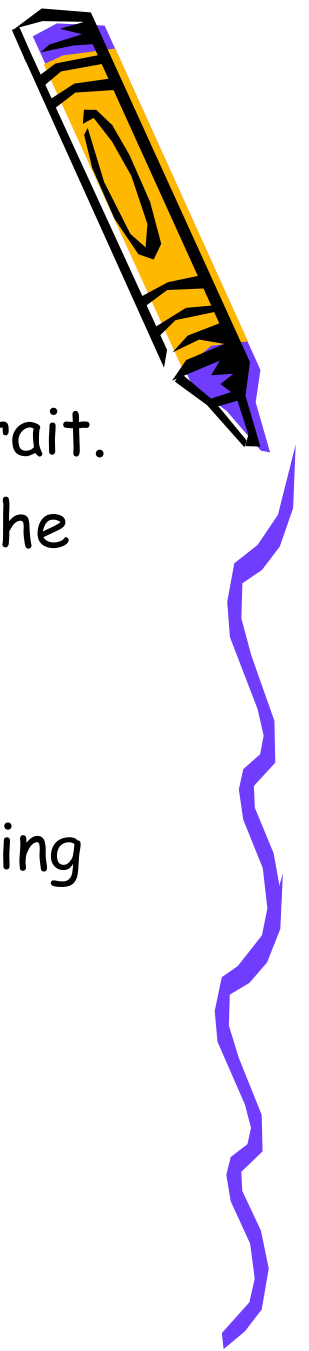

Monthly Character Celebration

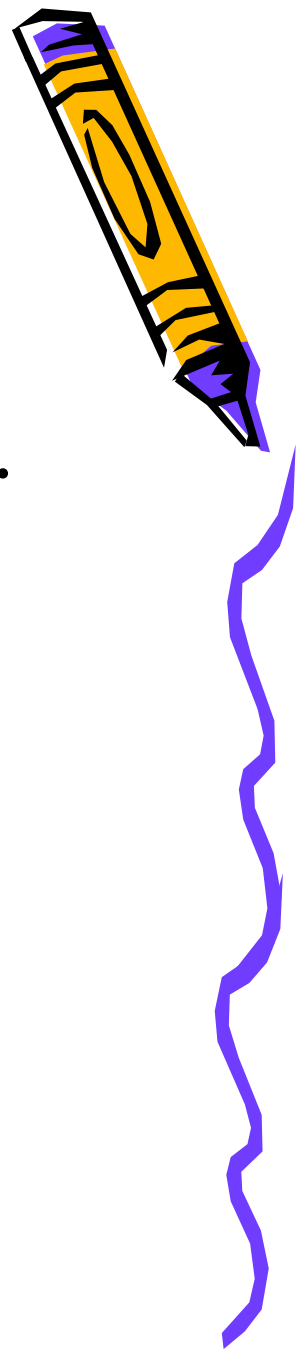


- Each month we will work on a new character trait.

- Look for the monthly trait to be listed on the behavior calendar and in the newsletter.

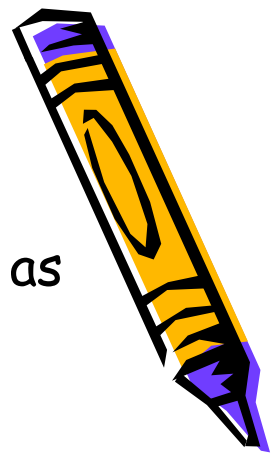


Kindergarten Rules

Discipline Plan

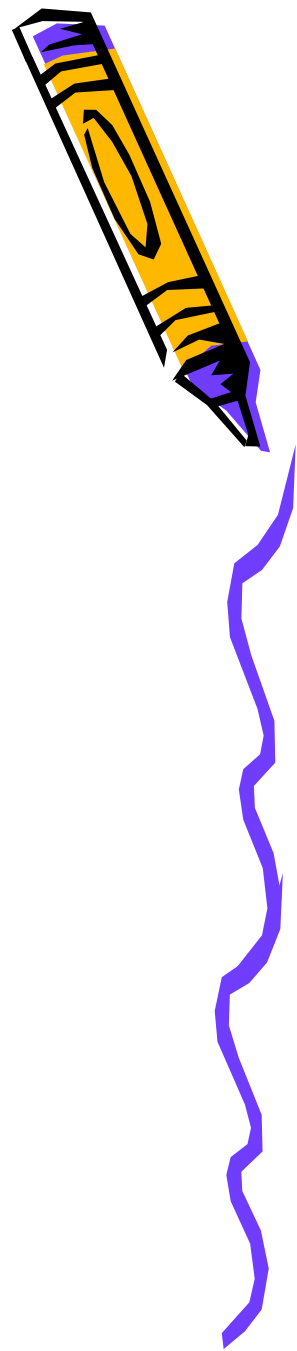


- Students will be redirected using logical consequences as needed. Parents will be notified of major offenses or continuous offenses.
- Second Step-character ed. program used to help teach children about good choices and appropriate behavior
- Olweus- anti-bullying program for school
- Behavior chart- Each student will automatically be given a sticker on their behavior chart for the day. It is up to them to make good choices to keep it. The sticker will be removed and replaced with a number in conjunction with the class rule they were having trouble following. Rules are posted on the bottom of the behavior calendar. Parents, please initial behavior calendar daily. I will collect calendars at the end of each month.

- You will be notified the week before so that you have plenty of time to prepare.



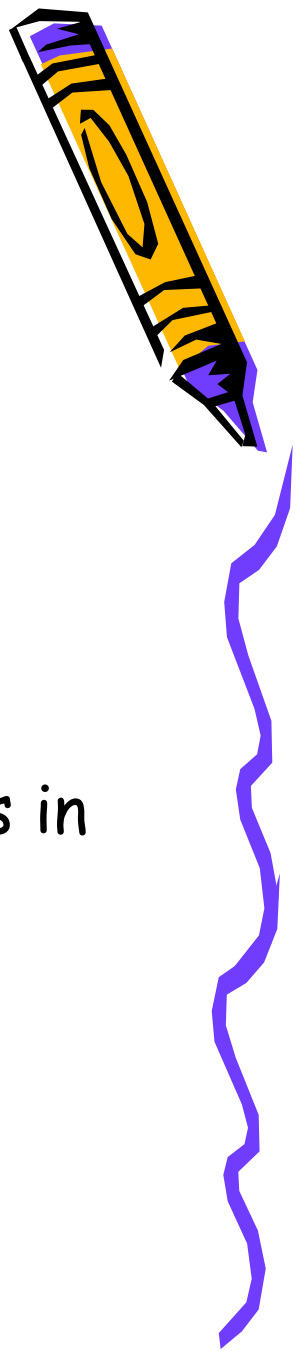
Birthdays

Snack

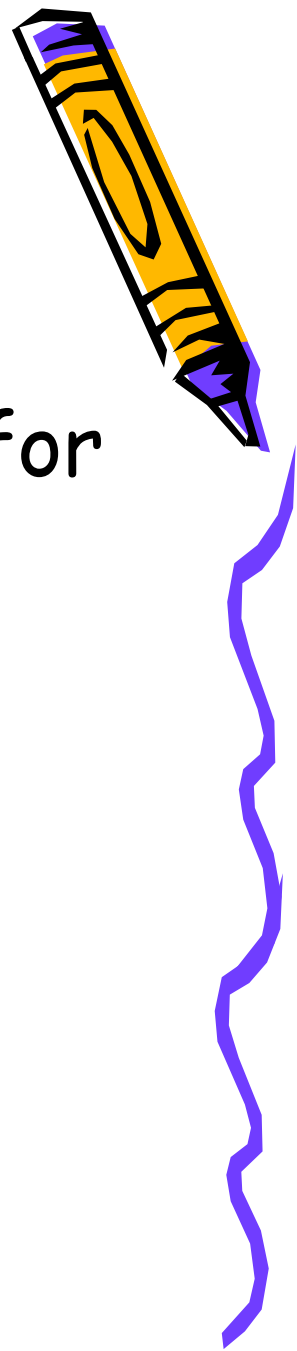


- I will send out requests for snack donations as needed.

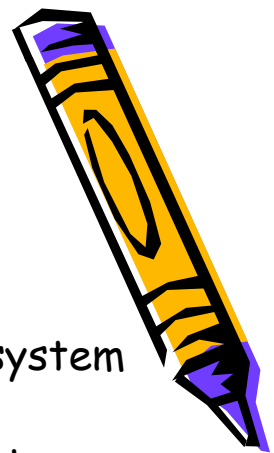
