This week we focused on the weather in conjunction with our EQ: What do animals do when the weather changes?

With Foundations, we began tapping words this week and I gave students a Unit 1 Assessment checking for letter names, sounds, and formation. I will be sending these home next week, so be on the lookout for them! We also leaned our first word family, **-at** and 3 new sight words—**on, will, into**.

In math we focused on making and taking apart the numbers 8, 9, and 10. We used linking cubes to help us discover different combinations for each number. We also began discussing addition.
