3rd quarter Historical Book Requirement

Each quarter you will be required to read one AR book that fits a topic we are covering in social studies. You may read either historical fiction or historical non-fiction as long as it relates to the time period being covered for this semester which are the following: Industrial Revolution, 19th and 20th century immigration to the U.S., the Progressive Era, Imperialism, World War I, or The Great Depression. Please check the middle area displays in the Media Center to get a book for this assignment or you may also feel free to pick an AR book from home or the public library to fulfill this requirement.

Note: Although we will not be covering the Progressive Era this year (from approximately 1890- 1920), there will be books available in the school Media Center on this topic, covering for example women's suffrage)

Once you have taken the AR test for your historical book, **print the TOPS report and turn it in to earn credit for this assignment.**

In addition to the TOPS report, you need to respond to the book reflection form (back side) in order to earn full credit. Please fill out the form with your name on it and staple it to the back of your TOPS report. <u>Note</u>: Additional book reflection forms are found in the folder close to the classroom door.

*Note: This assignment will be worth **20 points** (TOPS report submitted = 15 points and book response form = 5 points) toward your social studies quarter grade and will be **due by** Monday March 4th

***If you do not pass your AR quiz- you must also completely fill out a makeup form (which will be in a folder on the wall) in order to receive full credit.
