Ħ	- British passenger ship blown up by German U-boat (May 1915). >100 Americans killed.
1	 intercepted by Britain in March 1917. This along with sinking of American ships by U-boats brings U.S. into the war in April 1917.
Ħ	 May 18, 1917 Required all males ages(later changed to 18-45) to register for the 24 million men registered (23% of population) 11,000 volunteered.
Ħ	= information, ideas, or rumors deliberately spread widely to help or harm a person, group, movement, institution, nation, etc. (dictionary.com)
Ħ	 Posters were used to get Americans involved in the war effort. (they were also used by the Central Powers as well.) were encouraged to join the armed services. were encouraged to volunteer their services overseas. Emotions such as and were widely used as a way to get Americans to support the war.
