2. For **each** letter, you need to describe a different amendment (There are 12 letters in the phrase so you will need to describe a different part of some amendments more than once; you must have each amendment at least once).

*Note: You need a minimum of **1 complete sentence** per letter.

4. Be creative in your statements. It should not copy your notes but rather apply what the Amendment is all about.
