| Causes | Effects |

| Challenging life for peasants and working class (low pay, lack of food, dangerous work conditions) | Russia leaves World War I and signs the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk with Germany |
| Bloody Sunday (1905)- soldiers shot and killed protestors. The tsar is now seen as an enemy of the people. | Government takes control of industry and puts focus on that. Farmland is distributed to peasants. |
| World War I- Peasants and working class forced to join. There are massive Russian casualties (dead +wounded) | Women- given equal rights Religion- taken away from various parts of Russian life |
| Total power of tsar- he controlled much of life | Communism fully established with Red Army defeating White Army; the Soviet Union is formed as a country. |
