Directions: Please follow these directions as you complete your assignment today.

- 1. Read through both of the informational texts on African-Americans and women in the Civil War.
- 2. From **each article**, choose <u>5 phrases</u> to highlight that you think are very important or that stand out to you in some way.
- 3. On the back white board in the classroom, I have set up a <u>reader- response example template</u> for you. It is a way for you to interact with the text. You will have a quote on one side that you choose and your 3 sentence response on the other side. **Please do the following:
- a. Copy down the 2 reader response T-charts (on the back side of this handout). I have separated it into 2 sections. **Choose 2 phrases** (of the 5 that you highlighted) from **each** text to <u>write a 3 sentence response</u> (for each) in the appropriate area. Make sure to write the phrase down on the left side that you have chosen and your response on the right side.
 - b. Your response could be any of the following **or another way** you choose to react to the text:
 - i. Your agreement with it and why
 - ii. Your disagreement and why
 - iii. Put yourself in that situation and explain what you would be feeling and why.
 - iv. Talk about how life is different now and why.
 - v. Connect what the text says to a movie you have seen or a book you have read.
 - vi. Talk about what you are confused about in the text.
