Extra credit for social studies class

You may earn some extra credit points for your grade by doing the following. This should **be at least 3 strong paragraphs:**

1. Do some research on a topic we are currently studying (e.g. the roles of government, the causes of the Civil War, etc).

2. **Visit at least 2 reputable** web sites (those that are from an educational institution or an historical scholar) that provide information on something you would like to know more about.

3. Your **1**st **strong paragraph** should **summarize the information** from the websites (make sure to use parenthetical or in-text citations) to show where you got the information from.

4. Your **2**nd **strong paragraph** should be one in which you **draw at least 2 inferences** from the information. Please follow the format you have learned in language arts class. "I can infer that..."

5. Your **3**rd **strong paragraph** should be **your personal reaction** to what you have learned. How has this changed your thinking about the topic? What have you learned that impacts your life now, etc?

6. List the complete websites where you received your information from.

Note: This may only be done once per quarter. If this is done very well, you may earn up to 10 extra points added on to your grade. I may also add any point total between 1-10 points based on how well the process was done.
