## Major battles of World War II

- Intro: There were 2 major fronts that the Allied powers fought on during World
  War II- these are known as the European and Pacific theaters of the War.
- A. Major battles of European theater
  - 1. North Africa campaigns (1940-1943)- series of battles fought for control of North Africa and to keep control of the Suez Canal away from Germany. (This canal was the shortest sea route to Asia and the oil fields of the Middle East.)
    - a. The Allies took complete control of North Africa in 1943
    - b. They set up bases to attack southern Europe.

## Major battles of World War II

- -2. Battle of Stalingrad- (Sept. 1942-Feb. 1943)
  - a. Germany broke their pact and invaded the Soviet Union.
  - b. The Germans were eventually cut off from food and supplies and many froze in the harsh winter or starved to death.
- c. This is considered by many to be the turning point of World War II when the Nazis were stopped and pushed back towards Germany.

## Major battles of World War II

- 3. D-Day (June 6, 1944)
- a. The Allies invade France to seek to take control of France back from the Germans.
  - b. It was the largest land-sea-air operation in history.
- c. Many casualties were suffered but the operation was a success.
