Directions:

- 1. You will be given a piece of poster paper- make sure you put your name on it!
- 2. You will choose **10 photos** (2 per geographic theme) that are an example of that theme.

Note: Only cut out a photograph when you are SURE you will use it!

- 3. You need to give a **very good explanation/justification** for each photo and theme. Think about the following:
 - a. Explain a little what is happening in the photo.
- b. Use **a key term** from your 5 themes graphic organizer (page 14 of composition book) to demonstrate how the picture is an example of a certain theme. (e.g. = **adapt, physical characteristics**, etc.
 - c. You should plan on writing 2 sentences per photo.

**Other notes:

- a. Clearly label each theme and place photos right next to or underneath it.
- b. Make sure you do a very neat job pasting and using markers to write.
- c. You may use both sides of the poster.
- d. This assignment will be done in class. You need to use you time wisely and productively!
- e. You will put your name on the rubric (back side of this handout) and attach to your poster when you are done.
