- 1. Naval blockade of the South's coastline
- 2. Control the Mississippi River
 3. Capture the Confederate

- II. South (Confederate) strategy
- A. Fight a defensive war until the North tires and gives up.
- B. Get help from foreign nations such as Great Britain and France (depended on the South's cotton)
