- I. Introduction to Reconstruction
 - A. After the war
 - 1. Congress has passed an **amendment** (Jan 1865) that abolished **slavery** but the states still had to **ratify** (approve) it.
 - In April 1865, Lincoln was assassinated by John Wilkes
 Booth, a supporter of the Confederates.
 - 3. Vice-president **Andrew Johnson** became the 17th President of the United States.

- II. Reconstruction begins
 - A. Reconstruction was the time period between 1865 to 1877 where the U.S. tried rebuilding the South (its way of life and government)
 - B. There were three different Reconstruction plans: Lincoln's, Johnson's, and Congress'.
