Reign of Terror key vocabulary

- 1. **Reign of Terror** period of time (from Sept. 1793- July 1794) during the French Revolution in which massive amounts of people were accused and sentenced to death for perhaps being an enemy of the state. (against the revolution)
- 2. **Committee of Public Safety** a group given power by the French Revolution government that was responsible for carrying out the Reign of Terror.
- 3. **Maximillian Robespierre**-man with a large leadership role of the Committee of Public Safety who helped lead the Reign of Terror. He eventually was executed.
- 4. **Law of Suspects** law passed during the Reign of Terror which allowed people who were suspected to be enemies of the Revolution to be arrested
- 4. **Results of the Reign of Terror** the numbers vary for this, but it seems that at least 200,000 people were arrested during the time and over 40,000 were executed.
