

Forms of government quiz correction information

Directions: If you want to make corrections on your forms of government quiz to get back up to half credit on each question you missed, please do the following:

1. Put all test corrections on a separate sheet of paper; make sure to put the number of the question you were incorrect on.
2. Write out the correct answer to the question. **Do not put the letter of the correct answer, but write out the answer.**
3. In at least 2 **strong** sentences, with **good detail**, please justify why the new answer is the correct one. Add **more explanation** to help me know that you understand the correct answer. Explain **thoroughly** how the new answer correctly responds to the question. **Provide an example** that illustrates your understanding of the concept.

Note: Writing out the answer to the question (#2) does **NOT** count as part of #3.

Sample question (from government) - What is the main job of the executive branch?
Answer- to enforce the laws.

Explanation: Enforcing the laws means to execute them or to carry them out. The job of the President is to make sure that laws are followed after they have been made by Congress. He has many other organizations under him that help accomplish this such as the FBI and the EPA (Environmental Protection Agency).

4. Staple your original quiz onto your corrections and turn in.
