The U.S. in World War I

- Isolationism- the idea that America should stay out of foreign affairs and alliances, including wars
- Lusitania- British passenger ship blown up by German U-boat (May 1915). >100 Americans killed.
- Zimmerman Telegram intercepted by Britain in March 1917. This along with sinking of American ships by U-boats brings U.S. into the war in April 1917.
