• Short-term cause- The assassination of Austro-Hungarian emperor, Arch Duke Ferdinand was the spark that set off the War.

* Austria- declared war on Serbia. Other countries followed.

Fighting in the war

- A stalemate in the war led to trench warfare
- Advances in weaponry were tanks, airplanes, machine guns, poison gas, submarines (U boats)
- Both sides wanted America to join them and America was selling products to both sides of the war.
- Sinking of the *Lusitania* (a passenger vessel) and the interception of the Zimmerman Telegram eventually caused America to join in the war on the side of the Allied Powers.
