

CATS Homework, Agendas, and Blacklines

Homework:

- 1. We follow CUSD's policy for missed work due to absence: students have as many days to turn in work as the number of days they were absent.
- 2. Homework is due on its due date.
- 3. If a daily homework paper is one (1) day late, it is only worth 50% when it is turned in the following day. If a paper is two days late, it will receive a grade of a zero.
- 4. Long term assignments will lose 10% of the grade for every day the assignment is late (after an assignment is five days late it will receive a grade of zero).

Agendas and Backlines:

- 1. Student agendas will be checked by the CATS teachers on a regular basis.
- 2. Students will be blacklined for the following:
 - a. No homework
 - b. No supplies
 - c. Being tardy to class
 - d. No SSR book
- 3. If a student accumulates 3 or more blacklines in a week, parents will be notified and the student will be invited to a mandatory tutoring session which will be held the following week before school in Mrs. Scheitlin's room.

NOTE: We ask that parents do not bring the missing work to school for the student. Ultimately the work is their responsibility, and our goal is to get them on track for high school. We appreciate your help in this matter.
