

Homework, Agendas, Blacklines, and Detentions

Homework:

1. We follow CUSD's policy for missed work due to absence: students have as many days to turn in work as the number of days they were absent.
2. Homework is due when it is due.
3. If a daily homework paper is one (1) day late, it is only worth 50% when it is turned in the following day. If a paper is two days late it will receive a grade of a zero.
4. Long term assignments will lose 10% of the grade for every day the assignment is late (after an assignment is five days late it will receive a grade of zero).

Agendas, Blacklines, and Detentions:

1. Student agendas will be stamped by the CATS teachers on a regular basis.
2. Students will be blacklined for the following:
 - a. No homework
 - b. No supplies
 - c. Being tardy to class
 - d. No SSR book
3. If a student accumulates 3 or more blacklines in a week in the agenda, that student will be "invited" to a mandatory detention the following week before school in Mrs. Scheitlin's room. Parents will be contacted via email or phone.
