

CATS Technology Policy



Students are only allowed to use technology with their teacher's permission (smart phones, Ipads, Tablets, Kindles, and such).

Students are not allowed to use technology during a test or lecture, nor for anything unrelated to class. If they do, their technology will be taken away immediately. Parents will be notified of the violation, and they (parents) can pick up the technology in the office after school.

Per Bogle's technology policy, improper use of personal electronic devices is not allowed and could result in loss of network and BYOT privileges, disciplinary action, or legal action if appropriate.

Students are not allowed to text or email anyone during school hours - including their parents. If a student finds it necessary to contact a parent, the proper procedure will be to ask the teacher for permission to do so. Students are NOT to contact the parent requesting that they bring forgotten homework, books, or supplies as one of our goals is to reinforce responsibility in preparation for high school.
