IMPACT Enrollment

PLEASE NOTE: *Incoming sophomores for the 2021-2022 school year may opt into the IMPACT program until September 26, 2021. This extension is offered as a response to COVID restrictions during the student's freshman year that made it difficult for schools to convey program information to all students. The Foundation cannot extend late enrollment to any other student group. IMPACT students must be enrolled in a CUSD school for all four years of high school.

Incoming freshman (and sophomores for 2021-2022 school year*) may enroll in IMPACT via Infinite Campus. Freshmen may opt in at anytime throughout the academic year. Enrollment will be open throughout the year beginning on the first day of the school year. Freshmen must enroll through their Infinite Campus account. **Parents are not able to access enrollment directly but a confirmation email will be sent to the parent/guardian listed in Infinite Campus.**
