It is time to choose your classes for next year. Please register via the Campus Portal of Infinite Campus. Students must log into the Campus Portal and register for courses. Directions for registration are on our website. This worksheet is to prepare students for this online registration.

We hire teachers and create a master schedule based on student requests. Please consider your selections carefully, as we will be unable to accommodate schedule changes after schedules are created. By signing, we acknowledge that we have read the Course Description Catalog and understand any pre-requisites and fees associated with the requested courses.

**Note to Parents:** If you encourage your child to take an honors class, please have a conversation with this year's current teacher to ensure proper placement. Also note that leveling down in the future can be challenging if it means exceeding class size maximums. Students cannot change levels until quarter 1 progress reports (approx. 4 weeks into the school year).

- Students must register for 6 classes.
- Students must provide at least two (2) alternative choices for electives in case their original choices are unavailable.
- Students registering for Release Time (Seminary) must indicate this by filling in one of their electives. This will replace one elective and does not contribute toward graduation requirements. Students should register for Summer School, Chandler Online Academy or Zero Hour to replace this credit.
- Dual Enrollment courses vary from year to year due to teacher availability.
