Honors

- The Honors curriculum is geared toward freshmen and sophomores.
- Honors courses are available at Casteel High School.
- Grades in Honors classes are weighted.
- Honors classes are often taken in preparation for the transition to Advanced Placement courses in junior and senior years.

Advanced Placement (AP)

AP courses are offered at Casteel High School.

These accelerated courses prepare students to take the national AP exams (given in the spring) as well as help them prepare for the rigors of college.


If students score well on the AP exam, they may be granted advanced placement status and/or college credit.

- Students are eligible to take AP courses beginning their JUNIOR year of high school.
 - AP Human Geography may be offered beginning in the sophomore year. AP World History/Geography may be offered for freshman.
- Course information is available in the school's counseling office.

Home of the Colts PASTAL Dual Credit Enrollment

- Dual credit from a college may be granted in specified academic and/or occupational courses.
- Dual credit courses earn both high school and college credit for the same class.
- Dual credit courses will be taught at Casteel High School starting 2017-2018, in partnership with CGCC.
- Payment of tuition to the cooperating community college is required (scholarships may be available).

Physical Education (PE)

- 1 Credit of PE is required for graduation. There are, however, multiple ways to earn that credit:
 - Take a PE course listed in Course Description Catalog.
 - 3 semesters of Marching Band = 1 credit of PE
 - 3 semesters of Color Guard = 1 credit of PE
 - 3 semesters of AFJROTC = 1 credit of PE
 - Dance classes may be applied to PE credit
