The requirements for Student Council Officer are as follows:

- ✓ Students must maintain good grades (A's & B's with no more than 1 C in any subject).
- ✓ Students must have an "E" or "S" in all behavior grades on their report card.
- ✓ Students must be dependable, reliable, and adhere to the Student Council Constitution.

Students will be giving their speeches on Friday, May 25th starting at about 10:15 a.m. The C.T.A. 4th - 6th grade student body will vote for the candidates, and election results will be announced by the end of the day.

Please understand that students need to commit to participating in meetings and activities. Officers will have **weekly meetings**, held on **Wednesday mornings** at **7:00 a.m. in room 27** (annex). Please note that all elected officers and class representatives will be responsible for paying the current Student Council extra-curricular activity fee.
